xsign completed the signage package at St Theresa's Catholic Primary School, comprising the external school branding, internal door signs and outdoor post directional signs.

The external signs fitted to the building are made from 4mm thick brushed stainless steel lettering with bead blasted edge. We've also manufactured aluminium panels with digitally printed high tack vinyls, fitted to aluminium posts.

Internally, we've used our folio system to fix 4mm thick frosted lucite signs with high polished edge detail to doors.





The lettering that features at the front of the building is manufactured from 4mm thick brushed stainless steel.

The face is honed and hand polished to a 240 grit standard with an applied polish to preserve the finish.

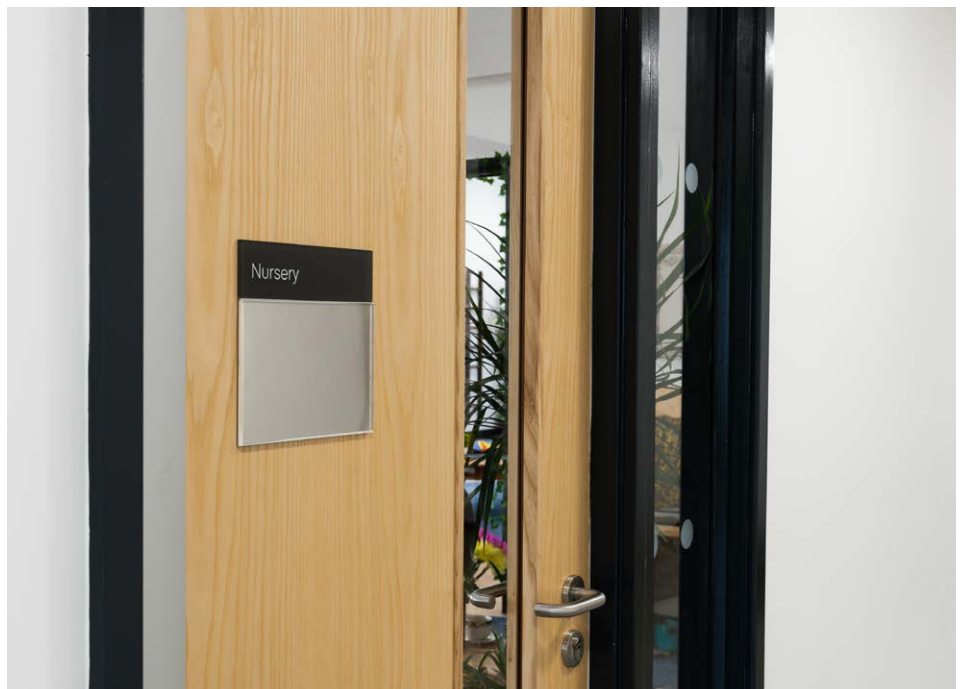
We've used the school's preferred typeface, Calibri.

Internally, school signs need to be tamper proof to ensure they cannot be defaced or broken.

We've used our folio system to provide a secure fitting and simple solution for staff members, who may need to change room designations quickly and easily.

The secret fixing system doesn't require any special keys or tools to operate.

We can use our folio system with any materials to create innovative and functional sign types.



Fitting signs at height requires some specialist capabilities.
